- BAADS Pirate Party Volunteer Opportunities
- Prior to Pirate Party, Unscheduled
  - Press and media releases assembled and distributed
  - Invitations distributed to big shots
  - Invitations distributed to SBYC, along with lists of volunteer opportunities
  - Use cat 'o nine tails to assemble volunteer crew
  - Edit the space pirate movie
  - Procure raffle prizes
  - Procure auction items
  - Procure pirate decorations
    - Spooky cloth (instead of the traditional plastic bag swags)
    - Skeletons
  - Procure pirate gear to sell
    - Bandannas
    - Gold coin candy
    - Costume items
    - Toys
    - Weapons
    - Barware
    - Fancy things
    - Weird things
    - Gambling gear
  - Gather and procure children's' toys, games and art supplies
    - A few suggested things to gather:

  - 6:00 PM:
    - Indoors
      - Decoration Crew
        - Drape ragged spooky cloth
        - Hang skulls liberally
        - Put chains on beer bottles
        - Fill the piñatas

- August 19, Saturday, rain or shine
  - 9:00 am:
    - Indoors
      - Move tables and chairs
      - Set tables with black, red and gold stuff
    - Outdoors
      - Unloading Schleppeing Sherpas report for duty
      - Rides for shut-ins
      - Move boats
      - Ready to sail/motor
      - Put up flags & banners
      - Hose off/sweep patio
      - Wipe and set out patio furniture
      - Set up ticket sales counter
      - Display sale items
        - Open BAADS register
      - Display raffle items
      - Display auction items
  - 10:00 am:
    - Indoors
      - Galley swings into full action
      - Grub gets lined up to grill
      - Breakfast and coffee/tea for volunteers
        - @ \$2.00 per (this is a fund raiser as well as a FUN raiser!)
      - Identify the outlets the band will use and lay down the extension cords and secure them with duck tape and make it really quack.
    - Outdoors
      - Assemble skippers and crew
        - Pour coffee into skippers and crew
      - Set up the puppet stage
  - 11:00 am:
    - Indoors
      - Final cleaning of galley before the locusts descend
      - Set up bar & open SBYC register
      - Children's story and art supervisor gets into place and sets up art, crafts and board games

    - Outdoors
      - Skippers and crew get ready to race or give boat rides
        - There is no other choice for all BAADS skippers: Race or Give Rides and all skippers will recruit crew
      - Assemble race committee
      - Act like roadies and help the band set up
      - Children's outdoor game referee gets into place and sets up paints and outdoor games

  - Noon
    - Indoors
      - Food to the buffet

- Outdoors
      - Seat the sales person
      - Get ready to give boat rides
        - Waivers to sign waving
        - Dock crew in place
        - Skippers in place
      - Establish the Pirate Costume fashionista who refuses entry to anyone not in Pirate garb, forcing them at plastic sword point to buy Pirate costume items at a dear cost of \$1 dollar and up.
- 1:00 PM:
  - Outdoors
    - First boat ride leaves
- 2:00 PM:
  - Indoors
    - Freshen the buffet
    - The auction begins
      - Chair massages by Ojocion and Valiance are among the items at auction.
  - Outdoors
    - Begin the Pirate Puppet Show
      - Will the Pirates capture the fairy tale princess or be eaten by sea monsters?
- 3:00 PM:
  - Outdoors:
    - Second boat ride leaves
    - Put charcoal in the BBQ's
- 4:00 PM:
  - Indoors:
    - Freshen the buffet
    - The Chair massages begin
  - Outdoors
    - Piñata breaking time
    - Start the fires in the BBQ's
- 5:00 PM:
  - Indoors:
    - The Pirate Cake arrives from Lido Pastry which will possibly be the finest cake in the world.
  - Outdoors:
    - Second shift BAADS salesperson arrives
    - Close first shift cash box and count down
    - Third boat ride leaves
    - Night Bar-b-q begins!
- 6:00 PM:
  - Indoors:
    - The band arrives and begins to set up
    - One round of Herbie-on-the-Rocks for all adults!
    - The Auction begins
  - Outdoors:
    - The skippers and crew bring in the boats
    - Shore crew cleans up the boats

- The South Beach Yacht Club cruise begins to arrive.
      - They will be thrashed into wearing costumes
- 7:00 PM:
  - The band begins to play
  - The dance contest begins
    - First round will be judged by children and youths under 21
- 8:00 PM:
  - Last chance to throw food on the bar-b-q
  - Cake and fruit are served
  - The children announce the first winners of the first heat of the dance contest
    - The second heat will be judged by the bartenders
- 9:00 PM:
  - Buffet is replaced by bar snacks
  - The bartenders announce the winner of the second heat of the dance contest
    - The third heat will be judged by Commodore Ed Gallagher
- 10:00 PM:
  - Close BAADS cash register and sales center
    - Hand all cash to Dylan
  - Raffle grand prize is announced
  - Commodore Ed Gallagher announces the third heat dance contest winners
    - Grand Prize winning couple will be chosen by applause.
      - Grand Prize winners receive a free chair massage.
- 11:30 PM:
  - Act like roadies and help the band pack up
  - Help clean the galley
  - Run the vacuum
  - Hose off the deck
  - Sort out the pot luck dishes to be returned to their homes
  - Help the bartenders clean up
  - Wipe the tables
  - Wipe the chairs
  - Load the trucks and cars
  - Call cabs for the drunks
  - Designated drivers load up their passengers
  - “Say goodnight Gracie” “Goodnight Gracie”
